



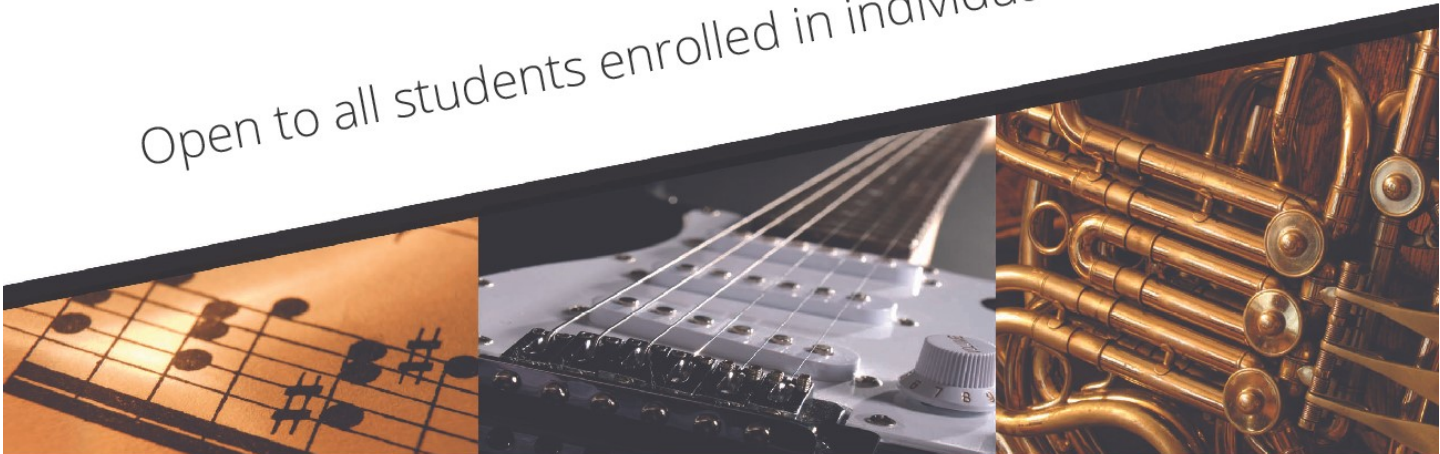

1. Visiting Instrument Day

Would you like to introduce your instrument to young children and inspire the next generation of musicians? Our First Music early childhood & elementary music program needs student volunteers to visit classes filled with young children and talk about their instruments. This is a great way to mentor and inspire younger students!

All instruments are welcome, though cellists, guitarists, and woodwind and brass players are especially encouraged to participate.
