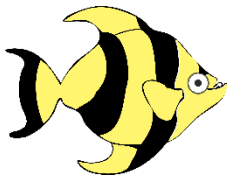

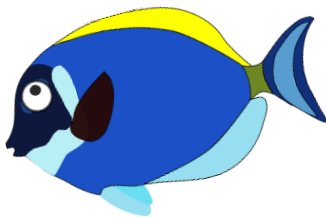

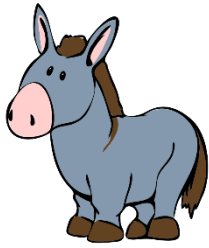

Carribean Folk Song



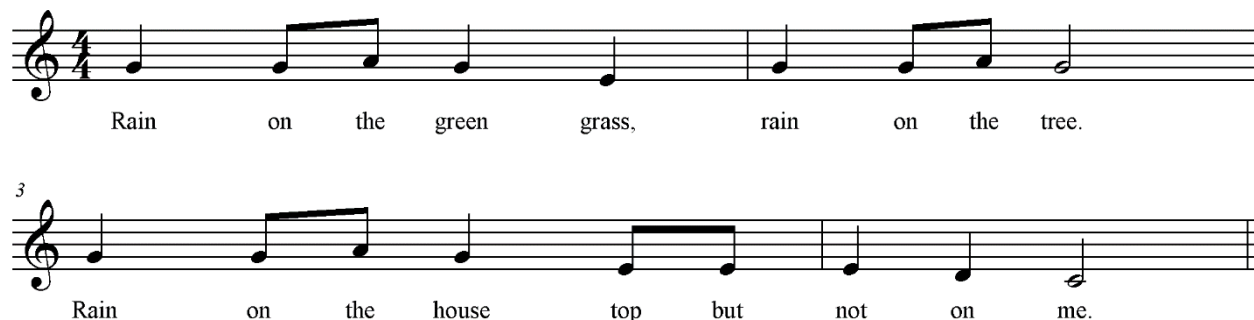

## Rain on the Green Grass

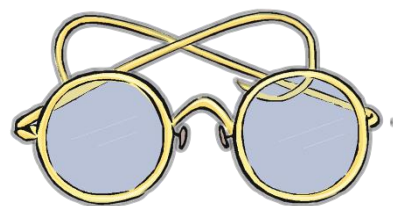


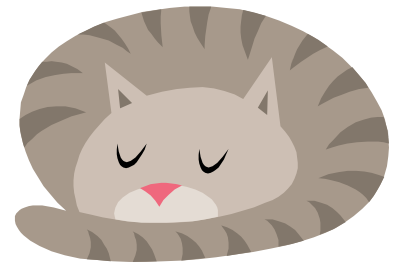

## Grandma's Glasses

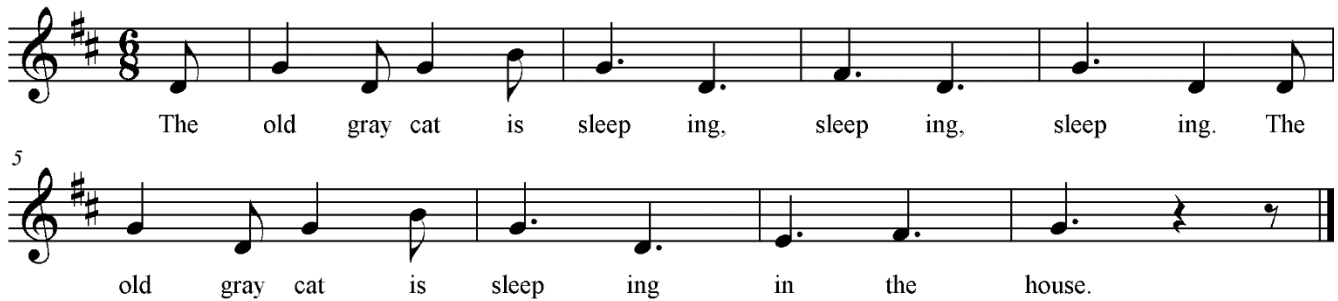
These are grandma's glasses,
